Subject: DISCONTINUATION OF ORDERLY ALLOWANCE.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this department's letter No.FD.PC.2-5/78, dated 02.03.1986, on the subject cited above and to state that the Governor of the Punjab has been pleased to discontinue the Orderly Allowance admissible to the officers holding posts in BS-20 and above working in the Punjab Civil Secretariat w.e.f. 31.10.2016. Similarly, its conversion into Special Additional Pension on retirement is also discontinued with effect from the same date. **However, those already drawing Special Additional Pension will continue drawing the same. The same will not be admissible to family of the pensioners on their death.** Accordingly, following policy instructions are withdrawn, with immediate effect:
