Subject: - **PROVISION OF UTILITIES ON GOVERNMENT EXPENSES**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the above-mentioned subject and to say that the Governor of the Punjab has been pleased to sanction the facility of Electricity, Water and Suigas at the residences of all the Administrative Secretaries at Government expenses with effect from 1st October, 2007. This facility will also be admissible to the Secretary (Services), Secretary (I&C), Secretary (Regulations), the Secretary (IPC), and the Secretary (Public Policy & Change Management) in Services & General Administration Department. The monthly expenditure involved at the residence of the officer on this account will not exceed the limit of Rs. 30,000/- per month.

2. Such facility already admissible to the Chief Secretary, the Additional Chief Secretary, the Principal Secretary (Finance & Taxation), the Chairman, P&D Board, the Senior Member Board of Revenue Punjab, the Principal Secretary to Governor and the Principal Secretary to Chief Minister will continue as such without any upper limit.



Subject: - **TAX DEDUCTED BY AG OFFICE ON REIMBURSEMENT OF PAID AMOUNT OF UTILITY BILLS AND ADJUSTMENT OF UTILITY BILLS ALLOWANCE ON ANNUAL BASIS (RS.360,000 PER ANNUM) INSTEAD OF RS.30,000/- PER MONTH.**

I am directed to refer Finance Department's letter No.FD.SR-I/9-14/2002, dated 17.10.2007 on the subject wherein the facility of Electricity, Water and Suigas at the residences of all Administrative Secretaries at Govt. expenses subject to maximum of Rs.30,000/- per month was sanctioned w.e.f 01.10.2007. A question has arisen as to whether the said facility can be adjusted on annual aggregate basis i.e. Rs.360,000/- per annum.


2. The case has been examined and it is clarified that reimbursement of facility of electricity, water & sui gas at the residences of all administrative secretaries at government expenses shall be adjusted on annual aggregate basis i.e. Rs.360,000/- per annum on the analogy of residential telephones as provided in the PFR Vol-II (Sr. No.51 of APPENDIX 14).
