

SUBJECT:- CALCULATION OF PENSION ON LAST PAY/EMPLOYMENTS DRAWN

Sir,

I have been directed to refer to this Department's letter No.FD-SR.II-4-58/86-C dated 10-8-1986 on the subject cited above and to clarify that the benefits of calculation of pension on the basis of last pay drawn is not admissible to those officials who were working on current charge etc. instead of on regular basis at the time of their retirement/superannuation. The condition of regular appointment is an essential pre-requisite for the admissibility of pension on the basis of last pay drawn. As regards the calculation of pension on the basis of average pay for the last 12 months, the benefit is otherwise admissible, but the calculation shall be made on the basis of pay at the rate which would have been admissible on regular basis to the concerned official, had he not been appointed on current charge basis etc. which is a temporary arrangement for a limited period.
