Subject: - **GRANT OF COMMUTATION TO THE WIDOW OF GOVERNMENT SERVANT RETIRED ON INVALIDATION BY MEDICAL BOARD BUT EXPIRED BEFORE SIGNING HIS PENSION/COMMUTATION CLAIMS.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that commutation up to 40% of gross pension is admissible to a civil pensioner at his option. Under the existing procedure, the entitlement of commuted value upto 40% of gross pension becomes valid as and when a Government servant, while in service or on retirement, exercises his option for commuted value of pension. Few references have been received in this Department wherein government servants, while having retired on invalidation by Medical Board, could not sign their pension papers due to their death. Consequently, the bereaved families of deceased pensioners were not given benefits of the commuted value of pension under the existing rules and orders.

2. The case has been considered and it has been decided that the family of a deceased Government Servant, who after having retirement on invalidation by Medical Board, could not sign his pension papers due to death, will also be entitled for the commuted value of pension henceforth.
