In continuation of this department's letter of even number dated 19.09.2009, on receipt of certain queries from different quarters, on the subject as well as regarding the admissibility of Ph. D. Allowance and Science & Technology Allowance it is clarified for general information that:

Sr. #	QUERY	CLARIFICATION
1.	What is the date of effectiveness for grant of Special Allowance to the teachers of Higher Education Department who have acquired/possessed M. Phil. Degree?	The date of effectiveness is 19.9.2009 for grant of Special Allowance to the teachers of Higher Education Department who have acquired/possessed M. Phil. Degree.
2.	What is the rate of the Special Allowance?	The rate of the said Special Allowance is Rs.2500/- per month which is the 50% of Ph.D. Allowance, i.e. Rs.5000/- per month instead of 50% of Science & Technology Allowance, i.e. Rs.10,000/- per month.
3.	Whether the persons who were in receipt of two advance increments upon acquiring/possessing the higher qualification as M. Phil Degree are entitled to the grant of the Special Allowance?	Those who were in receipt of two advance increments upon acquiring/possessing the higher qualification as M. Phil Degree are not entitled to the grant of the Special Allowance as double benefit of the same qualification cannot be granted.
4.	Whether Science & Technology/ Ph.D Allowance is admissible to contract employees or otherwise?	Science & Technology Allowance and Ph. D Allowance are admissible to those contract employees who are appointed in a pay scale in term of para 3(XIII)(i) of the Contract Appointment Policy, 2004. The terms and conditions of the admissibility of the said allowances shall remain the same as in the case of regular employees.
5.	When Science and Technology/ Ph. D Allowance is become due i.e. from the date of issue of sanction order or from the date of notification of M. Phil/Ph. D result?	Science & Technology Allowance and Ph. D Allowance are admissible to the government employees with effect from the date of declaration of result.



Finance Department has examined the above mentioned queries and observes that this department has already determined the eligibility criteria for grant of Special allowance equivalent to 50% of Ph.D. Allowance on acquiring/possessing M.Phil Degree by APUG/Ex-PCS/Ex-PSS vide letter No.FD.SR-1/10-6/85 dated 14.09.1991 and this facility was extended to the teachers of Higher Education Department vide this department's letter No.FD.SR-1/10-6/85 dated 19.09.2009.

3. In view of above, the **Administrative Departments are advised to deal such cases by themselves being competent to do so in the light of policy ibid.** As regards the equivalence of various educational degrees with the M.Phil Degree, the policy formed by the Higher Education Commission, Islamabad be followed by placing such cases in the meetings of **Qualification Equivalence Determination Committee (Q.E.D.C.)**.

I am directed to refer to this department's letter No.FD.SR-I/9-21/2011 dated 01.04.2013 on the subject noted above wherein it was conveyed that the Competent Authority has been pleased to extend the facility of M. Phil Allowance @ 50% of Ph. D. Allowance to all government servants across the board working under the administrative control of Government of the Punjab subject to the condition that they acquire the M.Phil Degree from the recognized universities of Higher Education Commission with immediate effect. But instances have come to the notice that the Administrative Departments are not complying with the said instructions in letter and spirit as number of cases are referred to this department for advice despite issuance of clear instructions in this regard.

2. Accordingly, it is once again brought to the notice of all concerned that the facility of M. Phil Allowance @ 50% of Ph. D. Allowance has been extended to all government servants across the board working under the administrative control of Government of the Punjab subject to the condition that they acquire the M.Phil Degree from the recognized universities of Higher Education Commission w.e.f. 01.04.2013.





Your kind attention is also invited to this department's circular letter No.F.D.SR-I-9-21/2011 dated 01.04.2013 (copy enclosed) wherein it has been stated that the Competent Authority has been pleased to extend the facility of 50% of Ph. D. Allowance to all government servants across the board working under the administrative control of Government of the Punjab subject to the condition that they acquire the M.Phil Degree from the recognized universities of Higher Education Commission with effect from 01.04.2013.


2. Accordingly, School Education Department's above referred letter dated 06.03.2013 needs to be amended as per following observations:

D Allowance per month is allowed to all officers/officials across the board without any restriction of scale. Moreover, Science & Technology Allowance, Ph. D Allowance and M. 
