GRANT OF AD-HOC ALLOWANCE - 2010 @ 50% OF EXISTING
BASIC PAY AND MEDICAL ALLOWANCE

I am directed to state that Governor of the Punjab has been pleased to sanction an Ad-hoc Allowance - 2010 @ 50% of the existing basic pay of Basic Pay Scales, 2008 to all the civil employees of the Punjab Government including contingent paid staff and contract employees employed against civil posts in Basic Pay Scales on standard terms and conditions of contract appointment with effect from 1st July, 2010.

2. The amount of this Adhoc Allowance:
 - i) will be subject to Income Tax.
 - ii) will be admissible during leave and entire period of LPR except during extra ordinary leave.
 - iii) will not be treated as part of emoluments for the purpose of calculation of pension/gratuity and recovery of House Rent.
 - iv) will not be admissible to the employees during the tenure of their posting/deputation abroad.
 - v) will be admissible to the employees on their repatriation from posting/deputation abroad at the rate and amount which would have been admissible to them had they not been posted abroad.

3. The term "Basic Pay" for the purpose of Ad-hoc Allowance - 2010 will also include the amount of the personal pay granted on account of annual increment(s) beyond the maximum of the existing pay scales.

4. This Ad-hoc Allowance will not be admissible to personnel of Punjab Police, Border Military Police, D.G. Khan & Rajanpur, Baluch Levy D.G. Khan, Prisons, Directorate of Reclamation & Probation, Judiciary, and employees of other Departments who have already been allowed an allowance equal to at least one month's initial of pay


scales, i.e. teaching/non-teaching staff of teaching institutes including employees of Directorate of Special Education and employees of MPDD etc.

5. The Medical Allowance in lieu of Outdoor Treatment and reimbursement of medical expenses has been granted as under:

| S. No. | BPS | Existing Rate | BPS | Revised Rate |
|--------|-------|---------------|-------|------------------|
| i) | 1-16 | Rs.500/- p.m. | 1-15 | Rs.1000/- p.m. |
| ii) | 17-22 | Nil | 16-22 | 15% of basic pay |

Note: The existing facility of reimbursement of amounts spent on account of purchase of medicines by Government servants and local purchase of medicines by Government Hospitals for Outdoor Patient (OPD) will be discontinued. However, the existing facilities for consultation and diagnostic investigations at OPD will continue as before. Reimbursement/Local Purchase on account of Cancer, Hepatitis B, C and Insulin dependent diabetes would be admissible for OPD patients. The existing facility of reimbursement of all kinds of expenditure on account of Indoor Medical Treatment will continue as before.

6. The expenditure on above Ad-hoc Allowance - 2010 and Medical Allowance shall be met from the budgetary allocation for the year 2010-2011 by the respective Departments. In case of any shortfall, the respective Department may request for supplementary grants to be provided by Finance Department on submission of demands.



In continuation of this Department's Notification No.FD.PC-2-2/2010 dated 15.07.2010, I am directed to state that the Competent Authority has been pleased to allow the following diseases for out door reimbursement as well w.e.f. 22.09.2012:

1. Chronic Pulmonary-Cardiovascular & Circulatory Disorders.
2. Tumors, Malignancies, Cancer and chronic blood disorders (Thalassaemia etc).
3. Chronic Hepato-Renal Disorders, Organ Failure, Dialysis and Transplants.
4. Chronic Neuro-Psychiatric Diseases, Neuropathies, Epilepsy, Paralysis.
5. Chronic Inflammatory-infectious Diseases (Rheumatoid Arthritis, Hepatitis, TB, Tetanus etc).
6. Chronic Endocrine Disorder (Diabetes, Goiter, Pancreatitis etc).
7. Chronic Degenerative Disorders.
8. Poisoning, Dog and Snake Bite.
9. Drug Abuse, STD, HIV/AIDS, VHF.
10. Chronic Skin Diseases Allergies – Chronic Connective Tissue and Autoimmune Disorders.
11. Injuries including Orthopedics, Burns, Gunshot, Blast and Head Injuries.
12. Day Surgery (Obstetric-Gynaec Disorders, Deliveries, Cataract and Eye/ENT day procedures).
13. Shock, Cardiogenic Shock, Stroke and Electrolyte Disorders.

Against Sr. No. 21, Schedule-II, Part-I, Powers Common to all Departments to Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 2006 the following amendments shall be made namely:-

Explanation: - the designated sanctioning authorities shall obtain the sanction of expenditure incurred by them on the medical treatment of themselves or the members of their respective families, as admissible under the rules, from the authority under whose administrative control they are working

Note: - With the inclusion of Officer of Category-I, the special powers of Additional Inspector General of Police, an Officer of Category-I, reflected against Sr. No. 6 under heading Police Department, in Second Schedule, Part-II to the Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 2006 would cease to exist to avoid repetition.
